The footballers were PC Mark Graham and PCSO's Gary Tilling, Paul Baxter, Andrew Pound, Chris Baker and Jason Green.

We played six-a-side against teams of young people aged between 10 and 18.

The station team had beaten nearly all comers in the football matches organised by the Bradley Stoke Football Initiative, before finally being defeated in the last game on penalties.
